Feel free to keep going with more words if your child is keen.

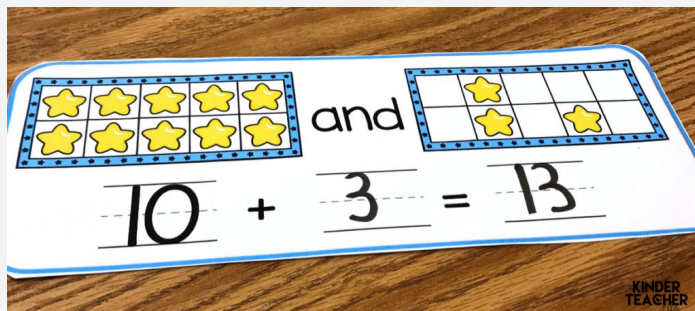


### Mathematical Development

**Our Learning:** Recognising, ordering and understanding teen numbers

1. Have a recap chat about how teen numbers are made
2. Get your teen number cards and have a go at ordering them. Then encourage your child to close their eyes while you steal/mix up 1 or more of the numbers. Get your child to sort the number line out. You can then close your eyes while your son/daughter has a go at causing some number line mischief!
3. This job is optional. If your child is keen/able, let them use their numicon shapes from last week to solve these calculations. PDF attached.

## Topic

Last week we were thinking about the people who help to keep us safe. This week we are going to start thinking about the people in our community who keep us healthy and well. Watch this video of the well known nursery rhyme Miss Polly had a dolly - Can you join in with the words and maybe find a toy that you can nurse better as you sing the song?

2. Can you craft your own medical bag - what kind of equipment would this bag need to contain?
3. Can you make a doctor or nurse hat to use in your hospital so that people can identify what your job is?

Your physical job for this week is to complete a daily mile either running or quickly walking!

In order for us to stay well and not get poorly like Miss Polly's dolly, we need to keep our bodies fit by exercising. Can you time how long it takes you to complete your mile each day?
