Tricky word: *snail* *cannot*



There is a snail on **my** path.

It has got **no** legs but it has a shell.

Well, **here** is a good fact! A snail has got **no** ears so it cannot hear.

Notes to parents: I don't expect the children to be able to read the tricky words straight away but if you've looked at them together before you start to read, the children should be able to get them in context. Once you've read a few times you can have a go at writing today's 'hold a sentence'...

It has got a shell.

Extension sentence: **The snail cannot hear.**
