

EYFS Developments –Understanding the world, Mathematics, Physical Development, Communication and Language, Literacy

Tuesday: Nature prints using paint, our surroundings are blooming with lushest green bushes, trees, flowers. Why not choose some and do some nature printing – you could also use pebbles and stones. Identify each one with your child and make a lovely nature print picture. It's just like leaf printing, simply paint your chosen nature object and print it onto paper, if you want to be really messy you could use mud instead of paint. Here is an example below:

Thursday: Fruit skewers/faces – Last week I made my own fruit skewers, I love fruit and I know lots of you Cherries do too. What fruit skewers can you make? They could have your favourite fruit on them like a rainbow. My favourite fruit is kiwi, banana, peach, nectarine and melon. You could even make a fruit face. Have a go and see what you can make. Don't forget to help mum/dad cut the fruit up safely and watch those fingers.

Friday: How many numbers can you find around your house, could be your door number, numbers on kitchen appliances, number on picture/photos, fridge magnets anywhere in the house and garden see which numbers you can find.

Monday: Let's make some playdough here is an easy and simple recipe for you guys.

- 1. Two cups of plain flour into a bowl
- 2. Half a cup of salt into the same bowl
- 3. Table spoon of cream of tartar into the bowl
- 4. Add in any extras likes glitter, herbs or food colouring
- 5. Adults only pour a cup of boiling water into the bowl and mix add extra if need be.
- 6. Allow to cool and get mixing.
