NOTICE OF FOOTPATH REFURBISHMENT AS PART OF OUR INVESTMENT INTO ROADS AND TRANSPORT THIS YEAR WORKS WILL TAKE PLACE TO

SWANSFIELD PARK ROAD, ALNWICK

BETWEEN THE FOLLOWING DATES:

THE 28th OF MARCH 2022

and

THE 15th OF APRIL 2022

A ROAD CLOSURE WILL BE REQUIRED.

SIGNS WILL BE ERECTED IN ADVANCE OF THE WORKS.

What are you doing?

We will be resurfacing the carriageway and footpath as indicated on the plan overleaf (areas highlighted in yellow & red). We have recently had to revise the extent of the works and we will not be resurfacing the top section of the carriageway and a small section of the footpath at this moment. This is due to the upcoming redevelopment of the old Dukes School and the new site entrance being in this section. We will however monitor the upper section of Swansfield Park Road and upon completion of the development, will carry out an assessment of the carriageway before carrying out further works.

Who will be doing the works?

The contractor for the main works will be Northumberland County Council

How long will the work take?

The works are estimated to take up to 3 weeks (*weather permitting*).

Will the works be disruptive?

To comply with health and safety requirements, the works will have to be carried out under a road closure. This will be between 08.00 and 16.30 Monday to Friday with the possibility of a Saturday morning. Specific sections of the footpath will be closed during the works and a pedestrian diversion will be in place using the adjacent footpath. Traffic management operatives will always be on site during the closure period. The works will be completed in two sections, to always maintain access to Lindisfarne Road and Swansfield park. During the closure a vehicular diversion will be in place but please liaise with the site staff if you require any special access / egress arrangements.

Every effort will be made to minimise the effects and duration of the works; however, some disruption/waiting time will be inevitable.
