English - Writing a Booklet

Today is Safer Internet Day - an opportunity to learn about how to use the internet safely.

1. Listen to the story of Smartie the Penguin as he learns how to use his new tablet and find out as many ways as possible you can stay safe on the internet.
2. Make an information booklet or leaflet to tell people how to be safe on the internet. Try to use conjunctions to extend your sentences to explain WHY you must do or not do something. For example: "You must not tell anyone your password **because** they might log on and pretend they are you" .

If this is easy try it with 2 or even 3 dice!



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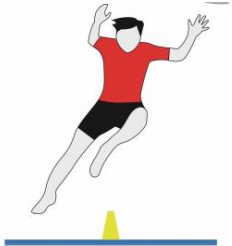
Topic - Safer Internet Day!
