<u>Our Learning :</u> To recognise:



All of the people working for the emergency services we have looked at this week do these jobs so that they can help people, but also so that they can **earn money**.

Why do we need money?

Watch this video of the traditional nursery rhyme: Sing a song of six pence:

Using the money sheets attached or better yet, using real money, can you join in with Mrs Horne-Smith as she is the king in her counting house, counting out her money?

- We should now know that there is no such coin as 6 pence, but we do know which coins we can use to make 6p. Can you do a job a day to help the adult you live with and earn 6p? They may choose to pay you in 1ps or by using a 5p and a 1p, but they cannot pay you more then 6p. Job ideas are helping to make the beds in your house or laying the table for dinner.
- 2. At the end of the week why not go to the shops and see what you are able to buy with the money you have earnt? You can have an adult help you to count the money you have earnt **altogether** to help you
