- Fine motor development
- Clapping syllables in words- fi-re-figh-ter, chi-cken, flow-er, mi-ni-beast
- Learning more about growing outdoors

Summer 1 General Aims — N2 (September intake children- those moving to Reception in September)

- Respecting each other
- Developing our independence and self-help skills
- Developing concentration and perseverance
- Listening to others
- Name writing/Pencil grip (**I will attach a letter formation booklet onto my blog wb 20th April**)
- Rhyme and alliteration
- Number recognition/ Beginning to use language around addition/subtraction
- Learning more about growing outdoors
