Communication and Language

This week let's have some fun with **alliteration!** Alliteration is when a group of words begin with the same sound. See the alliteration ideas sheet attached for some ideas.

First- go on a letter hunt. Look inside and out and find 3 things that begin with the same sound. What letter will you choose?

Now we have thought about words that begin with the same sound, can you help zoe the zookeeper name her animals? She wants the names to start with the same sound as the animal. For example. Tommy tiger, Lucy lion, Harry hippo. Can you think of some names for the pandas, snakes and monkey?

<u>Maths</u>

Apple class are getting really good at counting! Not just rote counting, we are getting much better at touch counting and counting out set amounts. **Our next step is to work on order irrelevance.** For example- a lot of our children can count an amount of objects, but when I change them around, (but keep the amount the same) they often don't know how many there are and need to count again. Let's work this week on reminding them that the amount remains the same unless we add or take away some objects. We will also have a go at some simple practical addition as we move through the week.

Let's warm up our brains by counting forwards and backwards to 20!

Our first challenge is to simply gather some objects/toys from around the house (up to 5 at first) and count how many you have. Move them around (don't add or take away any) and count them again? Is the amount the same or different? Why?

Now have a go at the car challenge attached. You can use the attached sheet and if you don't have cars, you can use stones, shells or other toys to represent them. Or. you can use the sheet as a prompt and use cars you have at home and make your own garage.
