Dear Parents & Carers,

We have organised for our Year 6 children to take part in an exciting, adventure-based residential trip to the Wilderness Outdoor Education Centre near Barnard Castle in County Durham.

This unique residential experience will take place from Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

Children will follow an action packed programme of adventurous activities each day and then relax under the stars with friends around the campfire at night. Adventure activities will include gorge walking, abseiling, orienteering, archery and stand-up paddle boarding.

Making their time away even more memorable, children will sleep in safari style bell tents, providing a unique and extremely novel accommodation experience. The safari tents come complete with comfy camp beds as well as 4 seasons sleeping bags and sleeping bag liners to keep us all warm and cosy at night. On site is also a large straw baled dining area as well as a large 'hot tent' with log burning stove which provides group refuge from the elements, perfect for a warm drink before bed too.

Children will be well fed with delicious home cooked, tasty meals; from cooked breakfasts, barbecued burgers, buffet lunches to hot chocolate and brownies before bed.

The total cost of the trip is £295. This includes full board, accommodation, travel, equipment, and instruction. Payment can be made in full or can be spread over the next few months as follows:

- Deposit of £45 due by 31st October 2021
- £50 due by 26<sup>th</sup> November 2021 £50 due by 17<sup>th</sup> December 2021 £50 due by 28<sup>th</sup> January 2022
- £50 due by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022
- £50 due by 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022
