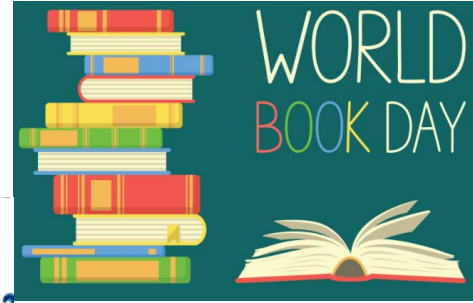


Oak Class Home Learning: Thursday 4th March

English - World Book Day

Maths - Dividing by 10

Let's learn:

Today we're going to divide by 10. Watch the video and have a go at the worksheet.

Practical Maths:

Ask your family if they can lend you some 10p coins. Put them in different piles and count how many coins and what they are worth like 3 coins make 30p. Try with different amounts.



Topic - ICT

Yesterday, we thought about the different parts of a chicken. Today, let's think about birds in general. There's a game on Busy Things where you have to correctly label the different parts of a bird. Have a go and see how you get on - and if you finish that one, you could try the other "Parts of a..." games. Enjoy!

Task: On Busy Things there are some games to play about the parts of animals. You need to:

1. Log into School 360.
2. Click on "Resources".
3. Click on your class page.
4. Click on "Science" then "Animals" and scroll down to "Parts of a bird".
5. If you click "mark" you can check to see which answers are right.



Physical challenge - Step in, Step out!
