
RWInc session: Tuesday 2nd March.

New sound: ew

Look! There are three ways to make this sound! We have already learnt 'oo' (poo at the zoo) and 'u-e' (huge brute) - today we are learning 'ew' (chew the stew).

Speed sounds - read the sounds (not the letter name)

Green words - read these words by blending the sounds together

Red words - read these words but tell your child the word if they get stuck

Ditty - read the ditty more than once through (remember not to read it to your child first)

The girl drew a dragon.

The dragon flew away.

She dr<u>ew</u> a n<u>ew</u> dragon.

She made this one stay.

Once you've read the ditty a few times, have a go at writing today's 'hold a sentence': **she drew a big cat at the zoo** Extension: **you must chew your food with your teeth**
