Our warm up challenges our going to be fun and fast to get our brains thinking:

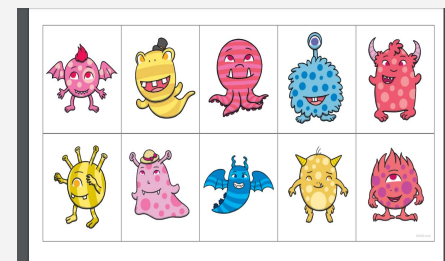
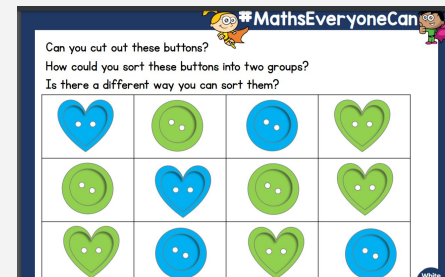
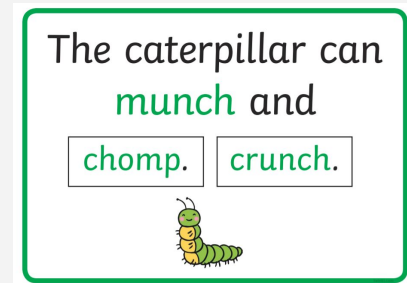
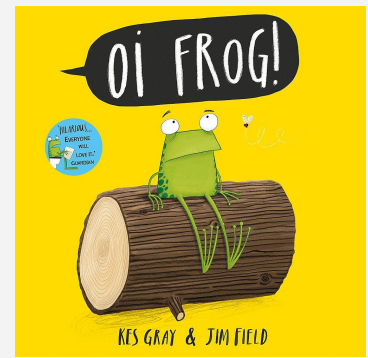
1. Can you find 3 objects that are the same but look slightly different?
