
RWInc session: Tuesday 23rd February.

New sound: ow

Look! There are two ways to make this sound! We have already learnt 'ou' (shout it out) - today we are learning 'ow' (brown cow).





Can you have a go at reading these green words:

cow loud now
shout down out
clown sound frown
how mouth brown

RWInc session: Tuesday 23rd February

Speed sounds - read the sounds (not the letter name)

e z i j p ur i-e igh a-e er

Green words - read these words by blending the sounds together

pet zip jam p<u>ar</u>t f<u>ur</u> b<u>i</u>k<u>e</u> fl<u>igh</u>t

case never chatter

Red words - read these words but tell your child the word if they get stuck

the is come said one they

Ditty - read the ditty more than once through (remember not to read it to your child first)

The farmer led the cow up the lane.

The cow is brown and white.

"Come on now!" said the farmer.

But the cow turned around and sat down!

Once you've read the ditty a few times, have a go at writing today's 'hold a sentence':

The cow is big and brown

Extension: Wow! I have never seen a cow frown like that
