- It is extremely important to name ALL clothing. In particular, shoes and cardigans/jumpers. These get misplaced easily and without names staff cannot find them easily.
- Please remember we are a 'Nut Free' school. If your child will be bringing a packed lunch to school, please do not send any items containing nuts.

Online Learning Journal



In Apple Class, we use an online learning journal by 'School 360.' If you haven't used this before, it is an online learning journal which allows us to share observations from school, to celebrate your children's milestones in their learning and development, as well as suggested activities to do at home.

School 360 can be accessed online or via an app, if you wish to download it.

You can also upload your own photos and descriptions of exciting things that have happened at home and we will enjoy sharing these in school with the other children.

For those of you who are new to Swansfield this year, we'll send out details of how you can download and get started with this app.

Apple Class Weekly Blog

Every Friday we will share an Apple Class blog with you. The blog will inform you of all of the exciting things we have learnt during the week, as well as new vocabulary, which you can reinforce at home!

It will also include important information, diary dates and things to remember.

This will be accompanied by photographs, taken throughout the week, to really showcase the wonderful things we get up into in Apple!

On a Friday the blog will be sent to you via email, this will just be the written text and not the photographs. To access the whole blog including photographs, you will need to go onto our school website 'Swansfield Park Primary School.' Then, select 'classes,' and then select 'Apple Class.'

The blog creates a perfect opportunity for you to engage in your child's learning at home, by having conversations around the great things they've been up to during the week!

We will share the posters in group sessions to learn about each other before creating a display in the classroom. In addition to the poster, please do encourage your child to bring in leaves, conkers, acorns, pine cones and twigs, for our Autumn display.
