

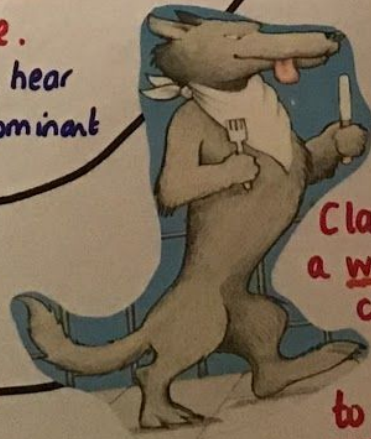
On the way home...

Note for parents...
your child can choose any
of the characters - the really
important part of this task
is for you to encourage your
child to be a storyteller as you
make a map together.

Here's Claire,
she's on her way
home because she
has a sore knee.

Your child may hear
and/or write dominant
sounds...

Claire met
a wolf and he
chased her.
He wanted
to eat her up!
Yikes!

Your child may hear
and/or write dominant
sounds... **wlf**



A cheeky snake
crawled from behind
a tree and tried
to wrap itself around
Claire! She ran away
fast!

Your child may
be able to hear
or write the sounds
in a word like 'fast'...
particularly if they
are in Reception.

Claire ran
home to her
mum and
told her
all about it!

Your child
may be able
to hear and
write the sounds
in mum -
again, particularly
if they are in
Reception.



Note for parents...

Once you've finished your map,
get your child to tell the story
you've made from start to finish.

Encourage the use of full sentences when
storytelling! Have fun!
