Today, we are going to focus on using commas to list. Make sure you complete this activity, as you are going to show me what you have learned when you apply commas to your letter writing.

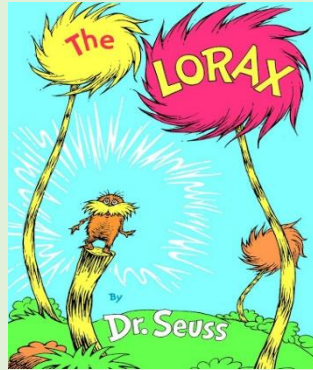
