#### Nut Free School/Packed lunches

Swansfield Park are now officially a nut free school and we would like to remind parents (particularly those bringing in packed lunches) that products containing nuts/traces of nuts (e.g. peanut butter/chocolate spread) are not allowed. Please ensure that your child's lunch continues to be in a named disposable bag. Thank you.

Please can I remind parents to leave any toys, sweets or precious items at home. As well as trying to reduce the amount that's being brought into school, lots of these items are getting broken or lost. Thank you.

As we have spent so much more time outside, walking and exercising in our gardens and local area; it would be lovely if we could have some pictures of your children in their favourite outside space—the garden, the park, the beach, or on their favourite walk etc. This will act as a stimulus for discussion and allows the children to share their experiences. These pictures will be used in class discussions (show and tell) then displayed throughout Summer term.

#### Clothing and Sunscreen

Please ensure that your child is appropriately dressed each day, and bear in mind that even in the short time your child is in school the weather can change dramatically. We will continue to spend much of the time outside, whatever the weather, so children will need to **bring named school sweatshirts/cardigans in every day**. As the weather starts to get warmer, can we please ask that children **bring a named water bottle and a named sunhat** each day too. If it is sunny can you please ensure that your child has had **sunscreen applied before they come to Nursery**. If your child is staying for the whole day, please bring in a **named bottle of lotion** and we will support them to reapply it at lunchtime. **If your child's feet have grown since you last brought in wellies, they may need a** 

new pair!
