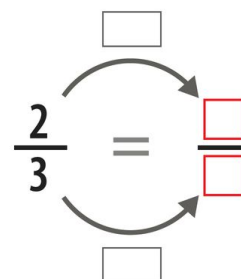
Round the number on the calculator to 1 decimal place.
