Personal, social, emotional development and Communication and Language are at the heart of everything we do in Reception. Autumn term is about supporting the children to become, confident, happy and settled in their surroundings whilst learning how to navigate new friendships. Everyday, we support the children to be effective communicators! Read, Write, Inc

- First we will be learning our single letter sounds (from a-z)- we will learn one per day and will practise reading and writing the sound.
- As your child learns more sounds, we will blend the sounds to read short words- for example, mat, sat, dad.
- We will send home learning videos every week so you can revisit the sound the children have learnt in school.
- There will be a RWI parents meeting coming up on how to support your child. Keep a eye out for more details soon!

Marvellous Mathematicians

- We follow the 'White Rose' and 'Mastering Number' scheme to develop a strong foundation and number sense for our children.
- We will be learning through practical activities and games.
- We will enjoy counting songs.
- We will sort objects and sets that are similar and different.
- We will compare sets, size, mass and capacity. We will then move on to explore pattern.

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Lets get moving- Jungle gym!

- We will practice moving in different ways.
- We will practise skipping. hopping and jumping.
- We will balance, move and roll like jungle animals as part of our jungle gym theme.
- We will be creating our own gymnastic sequence by joining together our movements.
- As well as PE sessions, children will have daily opportunities to develop their fine and gross motor skills by using scissors, tweezers, constructing in the garden.

Understanding the World

- We will be finding out about our families- what makes our families unique.
- We will be exploring travel and transport- how we travel, what we travel in and we will become curious investigators as we carry out some fun experiments.
- Then we will be learning about the seasonal changes and what this looks like all around us.
- As we approach Harvest time, we will find out more about the role of the farmer and the role of the combine! We will even get to see a real tractor close up!
