## PE and Swimming for the Autumn Term

## Tuesday Afternoons

Children in Years 5 and 6 will resume their curriculum swimming lessons on Tuesday 14th September. Two classes will swim per week, the other class will remain in school and have a PE session led by Newcastle United Foundation.

Children will need a named costume and towel in a small rucksack. Swimming hats and goggles are optional. Boys trunks / shorts should not be longer than knee length. Girls' hair should be tied up and please do not send toiletries. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, school will not be able to provide children with swimming costumes or towels. All children will be dismissed from school at the end of the school day.

Swimming lessons cost £2.20 per week. Please make payments online via School Money. Any child not taking part in swimming lessons will remain in school with the class that is not swimming.

The class who are not swimming, should come to school in their PE kit (as detailed below) ready for their PE session with Newcastle Foundation.

## Friday Afternoons

All children in UKS2 will also have a weekly PE lesson led by Newcastle United Foundation on a Friday afternoon.

In line with our Covid-19 Risk Assessment, we are asking children to come into school in their PE kit on the day of their PE lesson(s). The required PE uniform is:

- white t-shirt (plain or school logo)
- plain, unbranded black leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- purple shorts
- school jumper, cardigan or purple logo hoodie, now available from Border Embroideries
- plain black or white socks
- plain black or white trainers
