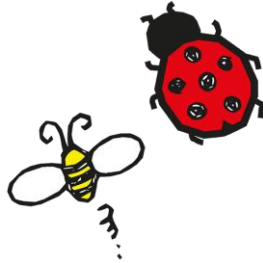


Wednesday 20th May:
