Let's go on a number hunt! Look around your house: how many things can you find that have numbers on? The kitchen is a good place to start! Good luck!

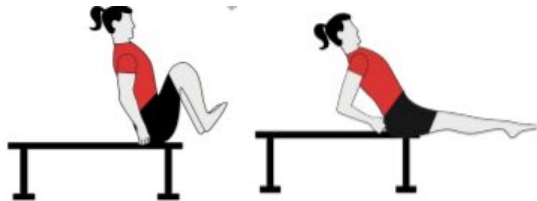
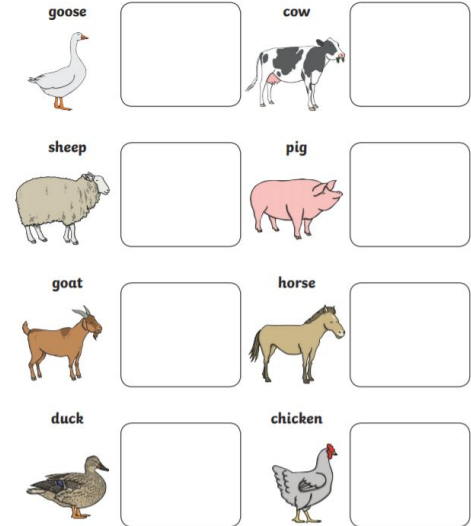
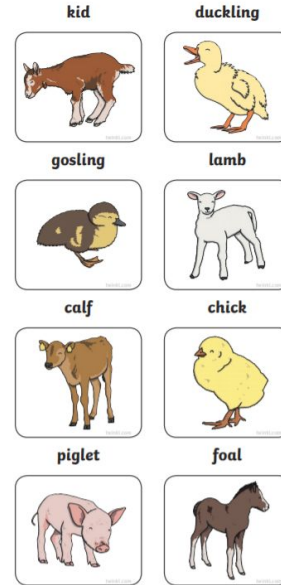


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## Topic - Farming: animal names.
