Maths - Compare mass.

Let's Learn:

Today we're going to learn how to compare mass. Watch the video and have a go at the worksheet. If you haven't got a printer, write your answers on a piece of paper or tell them to a grown up.

Practical Maths:

Choose two items. Hold one in each hand and see if you can tell which is heavier/lighter (or whether they are the same). Repeat with more pairs of items. You could also order some items from lightest to heaviest.

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Topic - paper aeroplanes!

How far can you make a paper aeroplane fly? If you don't know how to make a paper aeroplane, there are some instructions to follow. You might need to ask a grown up to help you. Once you've made it, launch it! How will you measure how far it's flown?

Physical challenge - socks in the box challenge!

How many socks can you pair up and put in a box in 60 seconds? Place unpaired socks 5 steps away from a box. Run, match up a pair, and put them in the box. If you do not have a box, use a wash basket or a bowl. You could add odd socks as red herrings!
