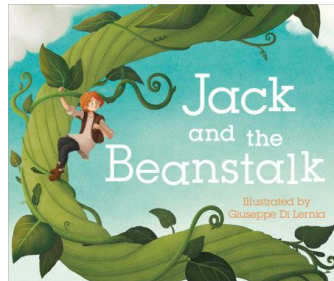


Wednesday 6th May:
