

## ***Impact of Sports Funding 2016/17***

Under the Primary PE and Sport funding initiative, in 2016/17 we received £8800 to support PE and sport within our school. The impact of the funding must be considered in terms of:

- Delivery of high quality PE lessons.
- Participation and success in competitive school sport.
- A broader range of activities on offer.
- Personal health and well being of pupils.
- Promoting pupil activity through involvement in organised games at breaks and lunchtime.
- Improved attitudes and behaviour towards learning.

We proposed to spend this money in the following ways:

<b>Activity/Resources</b>	<b>Amount</b>	<b>Evaluation of Impact</b>
KS1 specialised coaching, each KS1 class to receive a term of gymnastics coaching. Year round after school club open to Yr1 – Yr5 children.	£900	Due to unavailability of coach, children have had teacher led gymnastic lessons in school.
KS1 and KS2 specialised coaching in dance, 6 sessions per class. Possible after school club.	£1200	All KS1 children received a half term of dance coaching by a specialised coach. Children were taught technical steps, terminology and learnt a choreographed routine. Nursery children also received sessions.
<b><u>Football:</u></b> KS1 and KS2 specialised coaching, 8 sessions per class with coach providing 2hrs of coaching per week over a half term period. Possible after school club.	£1000	<b><u>Next Steps from 2016:</u></b> Each class to receive 8 coaching sessions. After school club and participation in competitions.  All children through Year1 – Year 5 have received sessions led by a coach. Some children have taken part in a year round after school club and attended a competition.
<b><u>Tennis:</u></b> Specialist coaching for tennis for Yr2/3 in the summer term together with a Yr3 tournament. Year round after school tennis club.	£600	<b><u>Next Steps from 2016:</u></b> Full term of coaching for KS 2 with an afterschool club and participation in a KS2 competitive Tennis Tournament.  Children from KS2 have received specialised tennis coaching. Year 3 children took part in a competitive tennis competition. Children from Year 1 – Year 5 were able to attend an after school club throughout the summer term.
<b><u>Rugby:</u></b> KS2 specialised coaching, 8 sessions per class with coach providing 2hrs of coaching per week over a half term period. Possible after school club.	£1000	<b><u>Next Steps from 2016:</u></b> Specialised coaching for KS2 with participation in competitive tournaments. After school club.  All children from Year 1 –Year 5 have received tag rugby coaching.

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		Children from Year 1 – Year 5 have been able to attend a year round after school club. Children from KS2 attended a tag rugby competition.
<b>Urban Sports Holiday Provision:</b> Urban Sport Holiday Club to encourage targeted children to participate in sporting activities during each of the school holidays. 5 places purchased per holiday.	£1200	Identified children invited to attend Urban Sports Holiday Provision.
<b>Cricket:</b> KS2 specialised coaching, 8 sessions per class with coach providing 2hrs of coaching per week over a half term period. Possible after school club.	£600	<b>Next Steps from 2016:</b> To continue to provide KS2 with cricket coaching with a specialised coach. After school cricket club available to KS1 and KS2 children in the summer term.  Both Year 5 classes received half a term of cricket coaching.  Children from Year 1 – Year 5 were able to attend an after school club during Summer 1
<b>Equipment:</b> Equipment to enable sporting activities and teaching to be carried out on school grounds, such as high quality netball posts and football nets. Suitable clothing for sporting events and to identify sports leaders.	£1585	Equipment for PE researched and discussed. Suitable equipment for upper KS2, storage for equipment and yard markings planned for 2017/18.  Sports Leader t-shirts and new sports kits needed.
Transport for interschool tournaments.	£1000	<b>Next Steps from 2016:</b> Participation in interschool competitive tournaments is a priority.  KS2 children have travelled to range of sporting competitions this year including, tennis, football, rugby and multiskills events.
Whole school archery day.	£300	Unable to arrange for this school year.
PE Coordinator CPD	£295	Unable to arrange for this school year.
