Week 3: Clara Schumann Piano Sonata III Scherzo

Clara Schumann was a German composer who was born on 13th September 1819 and lived until May 1896. In an era where music was dominated with male composers, Schumann was a rarity! This piece is part of her **Piano Sonala number 3**. A sonata is a piece of music written for a solo instrument and it consists of between 2-4 pieces. The piece we are listening to this week is the **scherzo** and it's one of the 4 pieces that make up this sonata. Maybe you could look up the other pieces? A **scherzo** is a light and playful piece of music which is usually quite quick in pace. Many composers have written scherzos - you could look and find some more.

I find this piece so cheery and I think it's a perfect piece for a spring day. It makes me want to get up and be busy! I wonder how it makes you feel?
