
## RWInc session: Monday 1st March.

New sound: oa

Look! There are three ways to make this sound! We have already learnt 'ow' (blow the snow) and o-e (phone home) - today we are learning 'oa' (goat in a boat).



Can you have a go at reading these green words:

NB: 'kn' = 'n'



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**Speed sounds** - read the sounds (not the letter name)

v p g j aw are ur er

**Green words** - read these words by blending the sounds together

vet pot gap jug cl<u>aw share</u> t<u>ur</u>n

le<u>tter</u> c<u>oa</u>t transl<u>ate</u>

Red words - read these words but tell your child the word if they get stuck

have you so to he his would tonight

**Ditty** - read the ditty more than once through (remember not to read it to your child first)

Have you ever seen a sight so odd?

A goat in a boat trying to catch a cod!

He throws out his rod and crosses his fingers tight,

He would like to have a fish supper tonight!

Once you've read the ditty a few times, have a go at writing today's 'hold a sentence':

Look! A goat in a boat
