English - Let's use those adjectives!

Adjectives are great! They help our stories to be more interesting and they help our descriptions to be more accurate. Remember, adjectives are words that describe nouns. Sometimes they come before the noun like: "I have a <u>fluffy</u> dog" or they come after the noun like "My dog is <u>fluffy</u>". "Fluffy" is the adjective. Have a go at the adjective worksheet below. See if you can describe the animals. If you don't have a printer, just write your answers on paper.



Maths - Dividing by grouping

Task: Choose one of these pictures to copy or do your own picture of a cow. If you have paints, have a go at painting or you can use coloured pencils, crayons or pastels instead.














Physical challenge - Squat Jumps!
