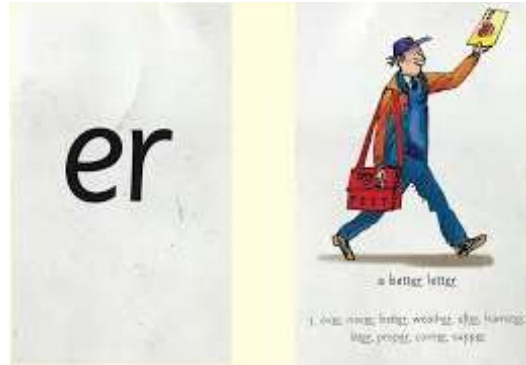


RWInc session: Monday 22nd February.

New sound: er

Look! There are **three** ways to make this sound! We have already learnt 'ir' (whirl and twirl) and 'ur' (nurse with a purse) - today we are learning 'er' (better letter).



Can you have a go at reading these green words:

NB: 'se' = 's'; and 've' = 'v'

after **bird** **hurt**

herb **never** **dirt**

proper **nurse** **letter**

better **nerve** **finger**

RWInc session: Monday 22nd February.

Speed sounds - read the sounds (not the letter name)

h d u w ng nk ar are ou aw er

Green words - read these words by blending the sounds together

hid duck wing think start share

outside yawning singer

Red words - read these words but tell your child the word if they get stuck

I to my said me her

Ditty - read the ditty more than once through (remember not to read it to your child first)

I sent a letter to my gran.

She said she had never had a better
letter.

After that, she sent me a gift.

Once you've read the ditty a few times, have a go at writing today's 'hold a sentence':

I hurt my finger at the park

Extension: I put a plaster on my finger
